### *Workplace Safety and Health in Basic Language (A Collection of Health and Safety Resources for the Canadian Learning Benchmark 1 to 3 Audience)*

The Health and Safety 101 Resource Guide is funded by Citizenship and Immigration Canada through the Manitoba Immigrant Integration Program. The kit and the activity suggestions were compiled and written by Lisa Petit, with the support and assistance of many colleagues in Manitoba (see Acknowledgements).

The kit provides Workplace Health and Safety materials for CLB 1 to 3 appropriate for use in the classroom. The manual provides an overview of the materials for lesson planning and the PDF format allows custom adaptation of the handouts and visuals. The kit includes six modules, usually containing four sections:

- Section 1: Background Information for the instructor
- Section 2: Suggested Classroom Activities and Handouts
- Section 3: Handouts referenced to the activities
- Section 4: Large coloured visuals (posters, flash cards, game cards, etc.)
