## TRANSIT POLICY

Centre can only provide Transit assistance to those students who **NEED** help with the cost.

### Who is eligible?

- Learners having medical issues or a doctor's note.
- Learners who are unable to attend without Transit assistance
- Learners who live further than 3 km away.

### Requirements

- Learners will receive one ticket in exchange for one transfer each day that they attend the program.
- Learners are required to sign a Mississauga Transit Agreement.
- Learners must attend school regularly and on time to receive tickets. If a learner is absent 5 days in a month without a doctor's note, assistance will cease until attendance improves.
- Parent must provide child's Immunization Record or Medical Exemption on registration day.

### Exceptions During Winter

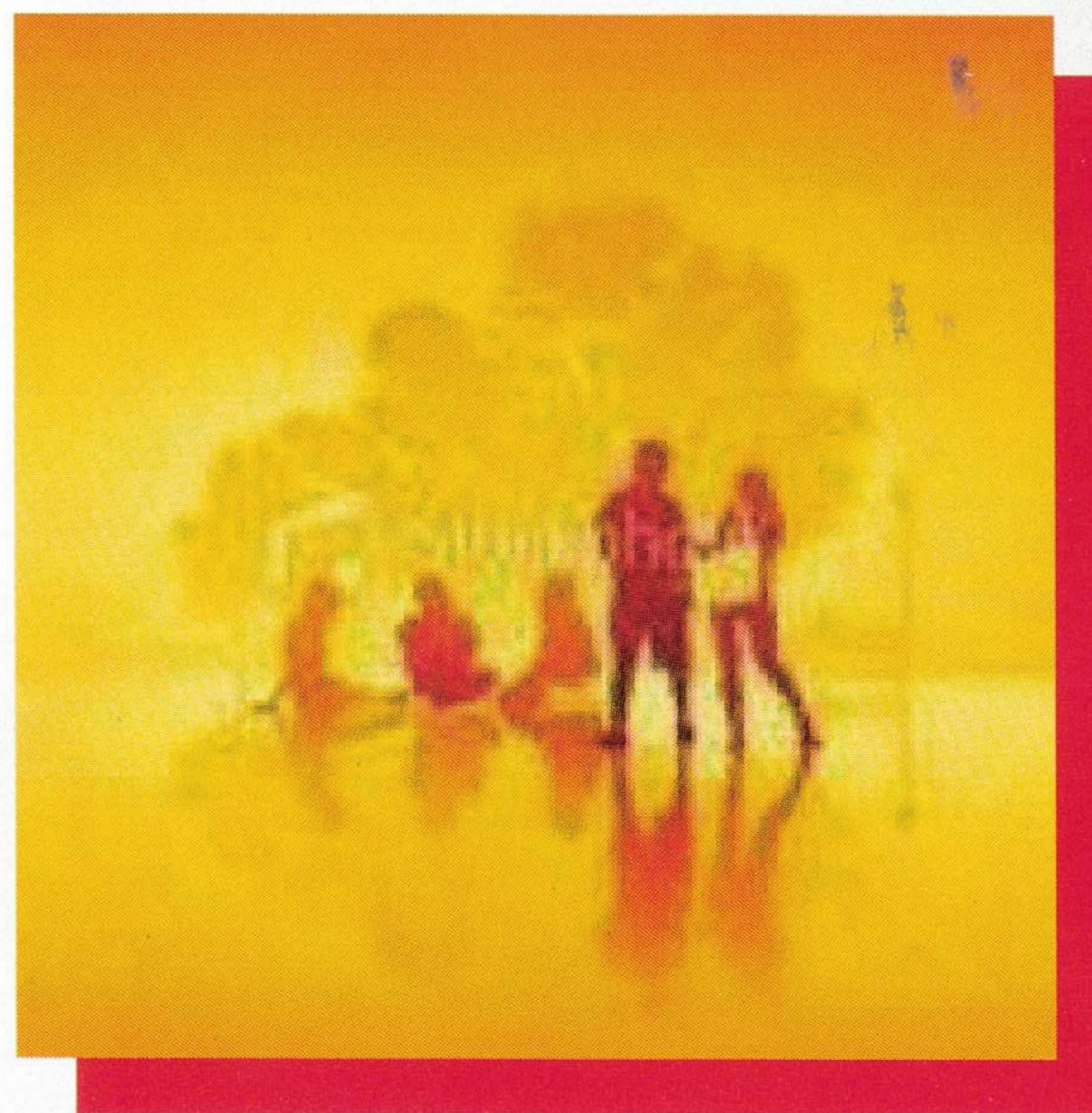
Seniors and parents with children may receive transit assistance.

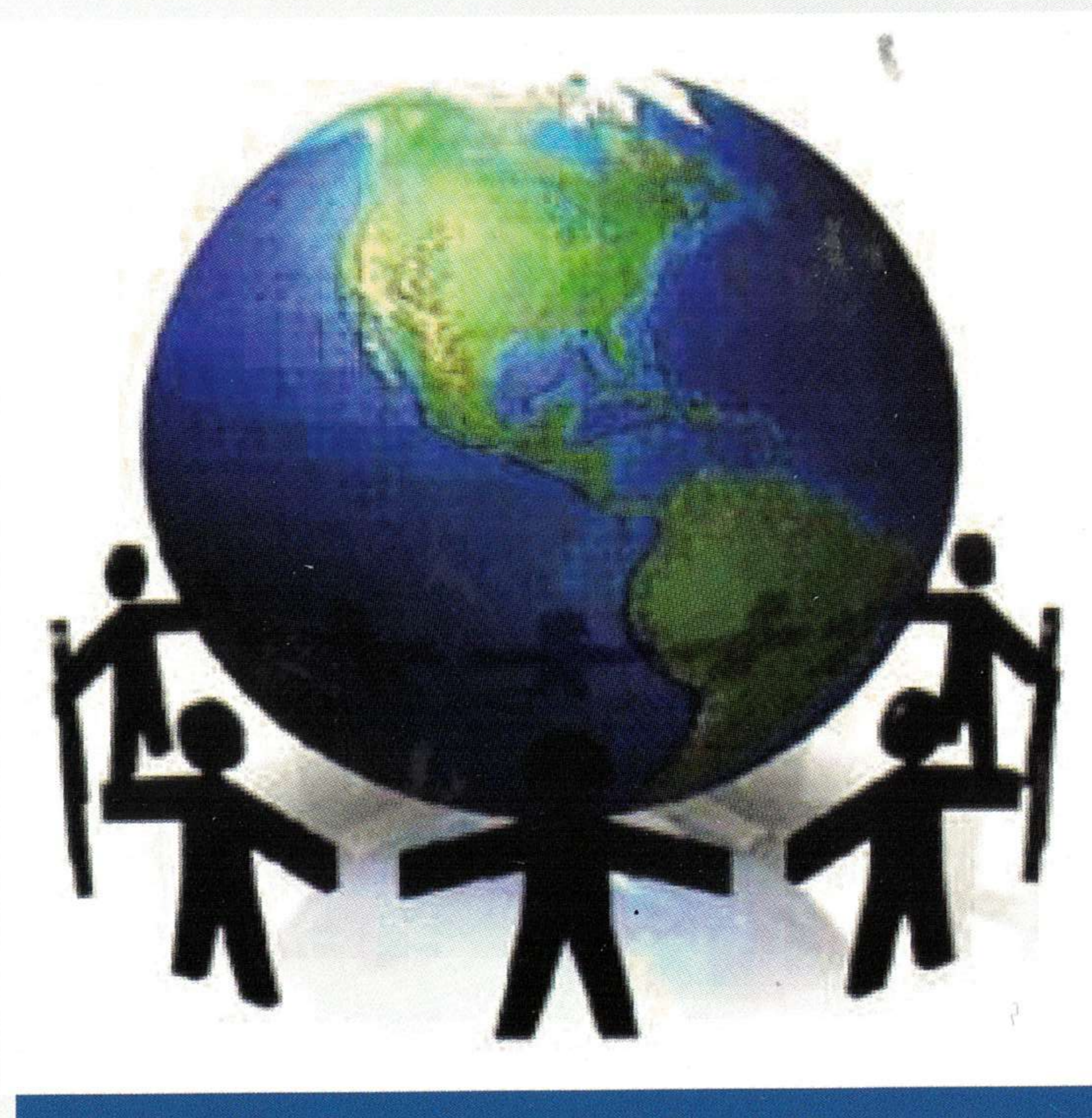
